



## Financing

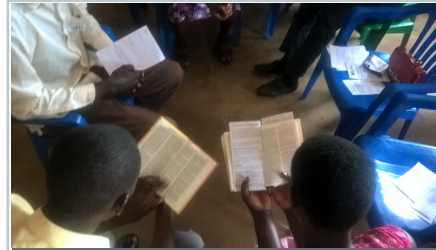
### How will the AMT be financed?

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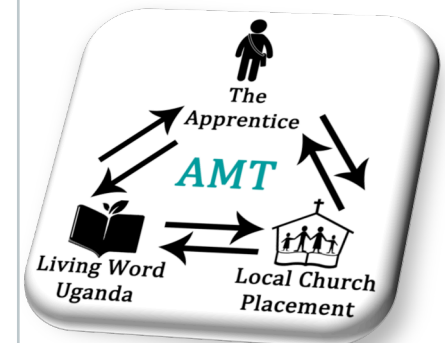

## Apprentice Ministry Training

### The What, the Why, the Who and...?

**WHAT IS IT?** // The AMT is a program by LWU that equips committed young men and women placed in a local church with the skills for faithful Bible teaching such that they are prepared to serve through gospel proclamation, church leadership and ministry roles.

**WHY?** // There is a need to equip the next generation of church leaders and missionaries with the necessary faithful Bible handling and teaching skills so that the church is led with holiness and the gospel is proclaimed faithfully to God's glory.

**WHEN?** // LWU will run its pilot apprenticeship training for three months from June to September 2016.

**FOR WHOM?** // **Committed Christians** who feel called to ministry and desire to be trained. The program also works well for people who are looking to **"taste" ministry** to work out if they think full time ministry is the way to go.

**For churches** that would love a helping hand in fulfilling their mandate of passing on the gospel to faithful men and women.

**HOW?** // Apprentices who join the program will be trained at LWU and placed with local churches where they will be able to put into practice what they learn and walk with a minister of God's word to learn the ins and outs of full time Christian work and the ministry of the church.

Mondays and Tuesdays will be spent at LWU in class, four days will be spent in the locale of the church where the apprentice will serve and minister in different roles and capacities depending on the placement. The remaining day of the week will be a day of rest.

AMT Classes will include the doctrine of God, the doctrine of Scripture, Missions, Understanding New Testament Letters, Understanding Old Testament Narratives and preaching groups among others.

We envision the program to be beneficial to the apprentice, the minister, and the church.

The apprentice will gain valuable knowledge, skills and grounding in Biblical convictions and teaching that serve as a strong foundation for ministry. The apprentice will also benefit from the mentorship from an older godly minister of God's word as well as fellowship with the church.

The church minister will not only invest in the growth and walk of a younger Christian, but he too will benefit from the preparation and introspection as he opens up to this young person.

The church will contribute to the development of the apprentice as the apprentice serves the church family and interacts with them. We cannot train apprentices for ministry away from the church thus the congregation plays a crucial role here as well.
